(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (5371)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Eastwood in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Proposed **prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

Edward Road, Eastwood (the north-west side)

- From its junction with Three Tuns Road in a north-easterly direction for 10 metres.
