

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BRACKENFIELD RISE, HADDON ROAD, LITTON CLOSE AND
TIDESWELL CLOSE, RAVENSHEAD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (7261)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Ravenshead in the Borough of Gedling: -

Proposed prohibition of **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

Brackenfield Rise, Ravenshead (both sides)

- From its junction with Haddon Road in a southerly direction for 11 metres.

Haddon Road, Ravenshead (south side)

- From a point 11 metres west of its junction with Brackenfield Rise in an easterly direction to a point 11 metres east of that junction.
- From a point 10 metres west of its junction with Litton Close in an easterly direction to a point 10 metres east of that junction.
- From a point 10 metres west of its junction with Tideswell Close in an easterly direction to a point 10 metres east of that junction.

Litton Close, Ravenshead (both sides)

- From its junction with Haddon Road in a southerly direction for 10 metres.

Tideswell Close, Ravenshead (both sides)

- From its junction with Haddon Road in a southerly direction for 10 metres.
