

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SOUTHDALE DRIVE AND SOUTHDALE ROAD, CARLTON) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (7263)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Carlton in the Borough of Gedling: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

Southdale Drive, Carlton

(the north-east side)

From its junction with Southdale Road in a south-easterly direction for 12 metres.

Southdale Drive, Carlton

(the south-west side)

From its junction with Southdale Road in a south-easterly direction for 17 metres.

Southdale Road, Carlton

(the north-west side)

• From a point 5 metres south-west of its junction with the cul-de-sac of Southdale Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 5 metres north-east of this junction.

Southdale Road, Carlton

(the south-east side)

• From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Southdale Drive in a north-easterly direction to a point 12 metres north-east of this junction.

Southdale Road cul-de-sac, Carlton

(the north-east side)

From its junction with Southdale Road in a north-westerly direction for 5 metres.

Southdale Road cul-de-sac, Carlton

(the south-west side)

• From its junction with Southdale Road in a north-westerly direction for 5 metres.
