

## THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STATION ROAD, BURTON JOYCE) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 2024 (7265)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Burton Joyce in the Borough of Gedling in the County of Nottinghamshire.

## STATION ROAD, BURTON JOYCE

- 1. The length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order shall be a Restricted Road (30mph) for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- From a point 11 metres north of the centre line of the railway crossing in a northerly direction for 53 metres
- 2. The length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order shall have a speed limit of 30mph
- From a point 11 metres north of the centre line of the railway crossing in a southerly direction for 66 metres
- 3. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order is hereby revoked.
