NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Carlton in the Borough of Gedling: -

Vehicles will be Prohibited from Stopping Mon - Fri 8am - 4.30pm along the following lengths of road: -

Southcliffe Road, Carlton

(the south-east side)

• From a point 54 metres south-west of its junction with Southlea Road in a south-westerly direction for 69 metres.
