

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DARLEY AVENUE AND
CASTLETON AVENUE, CARLTON) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC
REGULATION ORDER 2024 (7275)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Carlton in the Borough of Gedling: -

Prohibition of **Waiting At Any Time** along the following length of road: -

Castleton Avenue, Carlton (the north-east side)

- From its junction with Darley Avenue in a north-westerly direction for 11 metres

Castleton Avenue, Carlton (the south-west side)

- From its junction with Darley Avenue in a north-westerly direction for 8 metres

Darley Avenue, Carlton (the north-west side)

- From its junction with Castleton Avenue in a north-easterly direction for 19 metres

Darley Avenue, Carlton (the south-east side)

- From its junction with Castleton Avenue in a north-easterly direction for 23 metres
