

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CLIFF ROAD, CARLTON) (NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE CLEARWAYS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (7280)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Carlton in the Borough of Gedling: -

1. Vehicles will be <u>Prohibited from Stopping Mon – Fri 8am – 09.30am and 3pm – 4.30pm</u> along the following lengths of road:-

<u>Cliff Road, Carlton</u> (the south side)

• From a point 33 metres east of its junction with Parkdale Road in an easterly direction for 26 metres.
