

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ST ALBANS ROAD, DAYBROOK) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (7283)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Daybrook in the Borough of Gedling: -

1. Residents' Parking Bay along the following lengths of road: -

ST ALBANS ROAD, DAYBROOK (the south-west side)

- From a point 27 metres south-east of its junction with Church Drive in a south-easterly direction for 43 metres.
- From a point 44 metres north-west of its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-westerly direction for 81 metres.
- 2. Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

ST ALBANS ROAD, DAYBROOK (the south-west side)

• From a point 70 metres south-east of its junction with Church Drive, in a south-easterly direction for 12 metres.
