A60 MANSFIELD ROAD, PAPPLEWICK - PROPOSED EXTENSION OF 40MPH SPEED LIMIT (TRO 7284) - STAGE TWO CONSULTATION

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services.

Nottinghamshire County Council has received reports of accidents along the A60 at Papplewick. The road is currently subject to a 50mph speed Limit which is not deemed appropriate for this stretch of road with adjacent residential properties. It is therefore proposed to extend the existing 40mph Speed Limit approximately 800 metres north as shown on drawing H/SLW/5109/01.

Further to the stage one consultation letter of 6^{th} August 2025 the next stage of the consultation is to publicly advertise the scheme. The notice will be published in the Nottingham Post and notices will be fixed on site. A plan showing the proposals is attached (Drawing Number H/SLW/5109/02) along with a copy of the site notice.

Any objections to the proposals, specifying the grounds on which they are made, should be sent in writing before **28**th **November 2025** using the e-mail or postal address at the bottom of the letter. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.

Please be advised that all comments regarding this scheme, made during the Stage One Consultation period, still remain valid throughout this Stage Two Consultation period.
