TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026 (7290)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Redhill the Borough of Gedling -

1. Vehicles are **Prohibited from Stopping Mon – Fri 8am – 4.30pm** along the following lengths of road:-

REDHILL ROAD, ARNOLD (the south-west side)

From its junction with Cherry Close in a north-easterly direction for 38 metres
