

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (RANNOCH RISE, ARNOLD)  
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026 (7293)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No.1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Arnold in the Borough of Gedling:-

1. Prohibition of **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

**CALVERTON ROAD, ARNOLD** (north-west side)

From a point 11 metres south-west of its junction with Rannoch Rise in a north-easterly direction to a point 11 metres north-east of that junction.

**RANNOCH RISE, ARNOLD** (both sides)

From its junction with Calverton Road in a north-westerly direction for 11 metres.
