

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Epperstone Road Area, West Bridgford)  
(Prohibition of Waiting and Residents' Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order  
2017 (8263)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. To provide residents' parking places operating All days 10 am to 8pm along Epperstone Road and George Road, West Bridgford
2. To provide 2 hours parking, no return within 1 hour. Operating All Days 10 am to 8pm

Patrick Road, West Bridgford (the north side) - from a point 15 metres east of its junction with Musters Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 58 metres

Patrick Road, West Bridgford (the south side) –  
from a point 15 metres east of its junction with Musters Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres  
from a point 41 metres east of its junction with Musters Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 32 metres

3. Vehicles will be prevented from waiting at any time along:-

Patrick Road, West Bridgford (south side) - From a point 31 metres east of its junction with Muster Road for a distance of 10 metres

Epperstone Road, West Bridgford - From a point 33 metres south of its junction with Patrick Road for a distance of 23 metres

The provision is required to improve parking facilities for residents by removing non-residential parked vehicles from Epperstone Road and George Road and to provide short stay parking on Patrick Road.
