

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Various Roads in West Bridgford)  
(Prohibition of Waiting and Amendments to Residents' Controlled Zone)  
Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (8265)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along : -

**ABBAY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD**

(the east side) - From a point 15 metres north of its junction with Davies Road in a northerly direction to its junction with Radcliffe Road

(the west side) - from its junction with Radcliffe Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 16 metres

**AVON GARDENS, WEST BRIDGFORD**

(the north-west side) - From its junction with George Road in an north-easterly direction for a distance of 50 metres

(the west side) - From its junction with George Road in an southerly direction for a distance of 15 metres

(the east side) - From a point opposite a point 15 metres south of its junction with George Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 34 metres

**EDWARD ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (the south-west side) - From the boundary between properties No's 112 & 114 Edward Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 27 metres

**ETON ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (the south-east side) - from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Repton Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 12 metres north-east of that junction

**FLORENCE ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (both sides) - From its junction with Abbey Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres

**GEORGE ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (the north-east side) - From a point 10 metres east of the centre line of Epperstone Road in an easterly direction to its junction with Avon Gardens

**GRESHAM CLOSE, WEST BRIDGFORD** (the south-west side) - From a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Wilford Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 19 metres

**HOLME ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD**

(the north side) - From a point opposite a point 17 metres west of its junction with Mona Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 17 metres

(the south side) - From a point 17 metres west of its junction with Mona Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 17 metres

**MUSTERS ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (the east side) - From a point 19 metres south of the centre line of Eton Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 37 metres

**PRIORY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (north side) - From its junction with Abbey Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres

**PRIORY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (south side) - From its junction with Abbey Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 22 metres

**REPTON ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (both sides) - From its junction with Eton Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 metres

**TRENT BOULEVARD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (the south side) - From a point 18 metres east of the centre line of Rutland Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres

2. To change the position of the existing Residents Parking bay on :-

**PRIORY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (the north side) - from a point 219 metres east of its junction with Albert Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres

3. To amend the extents of the single yellow line :-

**PRIORY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD** (the north side) –  
from a point 210 metres east of its junction with Albert Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 8.5 metres  
from a point 224 metres east of its junction with Albert Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 8.5 metres
