

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Cotgrave Road, Clipston and Plumtree Road, Cotgrave) (50 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2018) (8280)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Clipston and Cotgrave in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

1. <u>Length of road in Clipston on the Wolds and Cotgrave in the Borough of</u> Rushcliffe

from a point 385 metres north-east of the centre line of the junction with Cotgrave Lane, Tollerton in a north-easterly direction to a point 178 metres south-west of its junction with Mensing Avenue, Cotgrave.

The proposed lower speed limit is being introduced to help reduce the speed of traffic on Cotgrave Road and Plumtree Road between Cotgrave and Tollerton. The lower speed limit will help to reduce the risks to vulnerable road users, especially cyclists. The new speed limit matches the average speed of traffic on the road.
