

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Bradmore Lane, Church Hill, Main Road and Station Road, Plumtree) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (8294)

<u>NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN</u> that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Plumtree in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

BRADMORE LANE, PLUMTREE

- (the north-west side) From its junction with Main Road in a south-westerly direction for 29 metres
- the south-east side) From its junction with Station Road in a south-westerly direction for 26 metres

CHURCH HILL, PLUMTREE

- (the north-west side) From its junction with Main Road in a north-easterly direction for 20 metres
- (the south-east side) From its junction with Station Road in a north-easterly direction for 23 metres

MAIN ROAD, PLUMTREE

- (the north-east side) From its junction with Church Hill in a north-westerly direction for 32 metres
- (the south-west side) From its junction with Bradmore Lane in a north-westerly direction for 40 metres

STATION ROAD, PLUMTREE

- (the north-east side) From its junction with Church Hill in a south-easterly direction for 38 metres
- (the south-west side) From its junction with Bradmore Lane in a south-easterly direction for 22 metres
