

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Asher Lane, Musters Road and Top Road, Ruddington) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (8304)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Ruddington in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along: -

ASHER LANE, RUDDINGTON

(the east side) –

- From a point opposite its junction with Distillery Street in a southerly direction for 100 metres

(the west side) –

- From its junction with Distillery Street in a southerly direction for 12 metres
- From a point 6 metres north of its junction with Top Road in a southerly direction to a point 10 metres south of its junction of Musters Road

DISTILLERY STREET, RUDDINGTON

- (the north side) - From its junction with Church Street in a westerly direction for 20 metres
- (the south side) - From its junction with Church Street in a westerly direction for 16 metres

MUSTERS ROAD, RUDDINGTON

- (the north side) - From its junction with Asher Lane in a westerly direction for 10 metres.
- (the south side) - From its junction with Asher Lane in a westerly direction for 14 metres.

TOP ROAD, RUDDINGTON (both sides)

- From its junction with Asher Lane in a westerly direction for 10 metres.
