THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CROPWELL ROAD, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT AND RADCLIFFE ROAD AND THE FOSSE,
CROPWELL BUTLER) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020 (8307)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads in the Borough of Rushcliffe

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on:

Cropwell Road, Radcliffe on Trent

from a point 420 metres south-east east of its junction with Dewberry Lane, Radcliffe on Trent in south-easterly direction to its junction with Radcliffe Road, Cropwell Butler.

Radcliffe Road, Cropwell Butler

From its junction with Cropwell Road in a south-easterly direction to a point 200 metres east of the centre line of its junction with Hardigate Road, Cropwell Butler

The Fosse, Cropwell Butler

From its junction with Cropwell Road in a southerly then westerly then southerly direction for 180 metres

2. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
