

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984****The Nottinghamshire County Council (Various Roads in Cropwell Bishop  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (8309)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Cropwell Bishop in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting **at any time** along: -

**CHURCH STREET, CROPWELL BISHOP**  
(the north-west side)

- From its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-easterly direction for 32 metres
- From a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with St Giles Way in a north-easterly direction to a point 15 metres north-east of that junction
- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with The Maltings in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction

**(the south-east side)**

- From its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-easterly direction for 25 metres
- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Stockwell Lane in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction

**FERN ROAD, CROPWELL BISHOP**

(the north side) From its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for 25 metres

(the south side) From its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for 101 metres

**FIELD LANE, CROPWELL BISHOP (both sides)**

- From its junction with Nottingham Road in a northerly direction for 10 metres

**HOE VIEW ROAD, CROPWELL BISHOP**

(the east side) From its junction with Nottingham Road in a northerly direction for 10 metres

(the west side) From its junction with Nottingham Road in a northerly direction for 12 metres

**KINOULTON ROAD, CROPWELL BISHOP**

(the east side) From its junction with Nottingham Road in a southerly direction for 10 metres

(the west side) From its junction with Nottingham Road in a southerly direction for 11 metres

**NOTTINGHAM ROAD, CROPWELL BISHOP**

(the north side)

- From a point 12 metres north-west of its junction with Old Lenton Close in an easterly direction to its junction with Church Street

(the south side)

- From a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Kinoulton Road in an easterly direction for 87 metres
- From a point opposite a point 20 metres west of its junction with Hoe View Road in an easterly direction for 46 metres
- From a point opposite a point 6 metres east of its junction with Mill Lane in an easterly direction to its junction with Fern Road

**OLD LENTON CLOSE, CROPWELL BISHOP (both sides)**

- From its junction with Nottingham Road in a northerly direction for 10 metres

**ST GILES WAY, CROPWELL BISHOP (both sides)**

- From its junction with Church Street in a westerly direction for 10 metres

**STOCKWELL LANE, CROPWELL BISHOP**

(the north-east side) From its junction with Church Street in a south-easterly direction for 24 metres

(the south-west side) From its junction with Church Street in a south-easterly direction for 22 metres

**THE MALTINGS, CROPWELL BISHOP (both sides)**

- From its junction with Church Street in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

2. Other restrictions: - **Bus Stop Clearway** – No Stopping Monday to Saturday 7am - 7 pm, except Buses

**CHURCH STREET, CROPWELL BISHOP**

(north-west side) **Bus Stop RU 0287** – from a point 59 metres north-east of its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-easterly direction for 19 metres

(south-east side) **Bus Stop RU 0288** – from a point 63 metres north-east of its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-easterly direction for 19 metres

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
