THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STATION ROAD, KEYWORTH) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT)
RESTRICTED ROAD ORDER 2020 (8312)

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order shall be a restricted road (30mph) for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
2. The following Order is hereby revoked in so far as they relate to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order: -

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Various Roads, Plumtree and Keyworth) (Speed Limits) Order 1992 (400)

3. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
4. This Order may be cited as "THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STATION ROAD, KEYWORTH) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) RESTRICTED ROAD ORDER 2020 (8312) and shall come into force on xx xxxx 2020.

SCHEDULE

All roads are in the village of Keyworth, in the Borough of Rushcliffe in the County of Nottinghamshire

Station Road

from a point 38 metres south of the centre line of its junction with Green Close in a northerly direction to a point 90 metres north of its junction with Park Road (an approximate distance of 403 metres)
