

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Nottinghamshire County Council (West Bridgford West Area) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (8317)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting **at any time** along: -

ELLESMERE ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD

(the north-west side)

- From its junction with Musters Road in a north-easterly direction for 12 metres

(the south-east side)

- From its junction with Musters Road in a north-easterly direction for 10 metres

GREYTHORN DRIVE, WEST BRIDGFORD

(the north-west side)

- From a point 5 metres north-east of its junction with Laughton Avenue in a southerly direction to a point 12 metres south-west of that junction
- From a point 10 metres north of its junction with Queensbury Avenue in a southerly direction to a point 8 metres south-west of that junction

(the south-east side)

- From a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Waddington Drive in a south-westerly direction to a point 10 metres south-west of that junction
- From its junction with Laughton Avenue in a north-easterly direction for 12 metres
- From a point 7 metres north-east of its junction with Queensbury Avenue in a southerly direction to a point 10 metres south-west of that junction

LAUGHTON AVENUE, WEST BRIDGFORD

(the north-east side)

- From a point 11 metres north-west of its junction with Greythorn Drive in a south-easterly direction to a point 11 metres south-east of that junction.

(the south-west side)

- From a point 11 metres north-west of its junction with Greythorn Drive in a south-easterly direction to a point 12 metres south-east of that junction

MALVERN ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD (both sides)

- From a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Musters Road in a south-westerly direction to a point 10 metres south-west of that junction

MUSTERS ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD (the east side)

- From a point 10 metres north of its junction with Malvern Road in a southerly direction to a point 19 metres south of that junction
- From a point 10 metres north of its junction with Ellesmere Road in a southerly direction to a point 10 metres south of that junction

MUSTERS ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD (the west side)

- From a point 10 metres north of its junction with Malvern Road in a southerly direction to a point 10 metres south of that junction

QUEENSBURY AVENUE, WEST BRIDGFORD (both sides)

- from a point 12 metres south-west of its junction with Greythorn Drive in a north-easterly direction to a point 12 metres north-east of that junction.

WADDINGTON DRIVE, WEST BRIDGFORD (both sides)

- From its junction with Greythorn Drive in a south-easterly direction for 12 metres

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
