

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Boundary Road, Musters Crescent
and Musters Road, West Bridgford) (Prohibition of Waiting)
Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (8325)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting **At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

BOUNDARY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD (the north-west side)

- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Musters Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 25 metres north-east of the centre line of that junction

BOUNDARY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD (the south-east side)

- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Musters Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 23 metres north-east of that junction

MUSTERS CRESCENT, WEST BRIDGFORD (both sides)

- From its junction with Musters Road in an easterly direction for 10 metres

MUSTERS ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD (the east side)

- From a point 10 metres north of its junction with Musters Crescent in a southerly direction to a point 10 metres south of that junction
- From a point 16 metres north of its junction with Boundary Road in a southerly direction to a point 17 metres south of that junction

MUSTERS ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD (the west side)

- From a point 20 metres north of its junction with Boundary Road in a southerly direction to a point 15 metres south of that junction
