## The Nottinghamshire County Council (Bede-Ling and Lyme Park, West Bridgford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2022 (8326)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

#### **BEDE-LING, WEST BRIDGFORD**

(the north-western turning head)

• From a point 58 metres north-west of its junction with Wilford Lane around the north-east side of the turning head for 18 metres

(the north-east side)

• From its junction with Wilford Lane in a north-westerly direction for 11 metres

(the south-west side)

• From its junction with Wilford Lane in a north-westerly direction for 11 metres

#### LYME PARK, WEST BRIDGFORD

(the east side turning head)

• From a point opposite the northern building line of number 34 in a southerly direction to a point opposite the southern building line of number 34 (a distance of 39 metres)
