

The Nottinghamshire County Council Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STRAGGLETHORPE ROAD, STRAGGLETHORPE) (50 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024 (8339)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Stragglethorpe in the Borough of Rushcliffe in the County of Nottinghamshire.

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on:

Stragglethorpe Road, Stragglethorpe

- From a point 40 metres south-east of its junction with the A52(T) Radcliffe Road in a south-easterly direction to a point 304 metres north-west of the centre line of its junction with Colliers Way
- From a point 275 south-east of the centre line of its junction with Colliers Way in a south-easterly direction to a point 200 metres north-west of the A46(T) (Slip roads) roundabout.
- 2. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
