

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HOLME PIERREPONT BYWAY NO 13) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (8346A)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended; the effect of which will be, in relation to Holme Pierrepont Byway Open to All Traffic No 13 in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. To prohibit vehicles other than pedal cycles from driving on

Holme Pierrepont Byway Open to All Traffic No 13, in the Borough of Rushcliffe

From its junction with the A52 Radcliffe Road in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Adbolton Lane.

THIS ORDER WILL COME INTO FORCE ON 3RD DECEMBER 2024.

National Highways have determined that it is unsafe for vehicular traffic to access the A52 (part of National Highways' network) from the byway (part of the County Council's network) and as such, vehicular access along the byway are no longer be permitted. While public vehicular use is prohibited, the County Council has determined that the length of the byway will remain open for public use by walkers, horse riders and pedal-cyclists.
