**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton Bonington in the Borough of Rushcliffe in the County of Nottinghamshire.

1. The length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order shall be a Restricted Road (30mph) for the purposed of Section 81 of the Act.

**PARK LANE, SUTTON BONINGTON**

- From its junction with the A6006 in a north-westerly direction for 200 metres.
2. The following Order is hereby revoked in so far as they relate to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order: -

The Nottinghamshire County Council (MAIN STREET (A6006), ZOUCH, PARK LANE, SUTTON BONINGTON AND MOOR LANE, NORMANTON -ON-SOAR) (30MPH, 40MPH AND 50MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2013 (8191)
