A60 LOUGHBOROUGH ROAD, RUDDINGTON - PROPOSED NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE MARKING (TRO 8350) - PUBLIC ADVERT

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services.

In order to fulfil a planning condition for the development of a new school at Easthorpe House, Loughborough Road, Ruddington, it is proposed to introduce a new School Keep Clear Marking (SKC) across the driveway entrance to the school.

The School Keep Clear marking will **prohibit vehicles from stopping Mon to Friday 8 am - 4.30 pm** outside the front of the school, which will make it easier and safer for pedestrians to cross the road to reach the school.

The proposals will be advertised, and notices displayed on site. A plan showing the extents of the proposals is attached (Drawing Number H/SLW/4112/01) along with a copy of the site notice.

Before proceeding further, I wish to consider the views of residents, businesses and organisations who may be interested in this matter. Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter or email, by **25th November 2022**. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals, please clearly state this and the reasons for your objection. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
