

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BRUCE DRIVE AND B679 WILFORD LANE, WEST BRIDGFORD (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (8353)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be Prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following: -

BRUCE DRIVE, WEST BRIDGFORD (both sides)

• From its junction with Wilford Lane in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres

WILFORD LANE, WEST BRIDGFORD (the south-east side)

 From a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Bruce Drive in an easterly direction for 22 metres
