

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HALL LANE, COLSTON
BASSETT) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023 (8358)**

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceed 40 miles per hour on that length of road specified at Hall Lane, Colston Bassett in the Borough of Rushcliffe as specified in the Schedule of this Order.
2. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
3. This Order may be cited as "THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HALL LANE, COLSTON BASSETT) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023 (8358) and shall come into force on xx xxxx 2023.

SCHEDULE

HALL LANE, COLSTON BASSETT

From a point 47 metres north-west of the centre of its junction with School Lane, at the base of the National Trust Market Cross, in a north-westerly direction to a point 30 metres north-west of its junction with New Road
