

## <u>THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL</u> (LANDMERE LANE, EDWALTON) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) <u>TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (8362)</u>

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Edwalton in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

## Landmere Lane, West Bridgford

(the north-west and north-east side)

• From its junction with A606 Melton Road in a south-westerly then north-westerly direction for 220 metres.

## Landmere Lane, West Bridgford

(the south-east and south-west side)

• From its junction with A606 Melton Road in a south-westerly then north-westerly direction for 222 metres.
