

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A606 MAIN ROAD, CHAPEL LANE
AND RECTORY DRIVE, UPPER BROUGHTON)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (8369)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Upper Broughton in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles are **prohibited from Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

CHAPEL LANE, UPPER BROUGHTON (both sides)

- From its junction with A606 Main Road in an easterly direction for 4 metres.

MAIN ROAD, UPPER BROUGHTON

(the north-east side)

- From a point opposite a point 34 metres south-east of its junction with Bottom Green in a north-westerly direction to a point 6 metres north-west of its junction with Rectory Drive.

RECTORY DRIVE, UPPER BROUGHTON

(the east side)

- From its junction with A606 Main Road in a northerly direction for 20 metres

(the north side)

- From its junction with A606 Main Road in a north-easterly direction for 9 metres
- From a point 37 metres north-east of its junction with A606 Main Road in a north-easterly direction up to and including its north-eastern extremity

(the south-east side)

- From its north-eastern extremity in a south-westerly direction for 14 metres.
- From its junction with A606 Main Road in a north-easterly direction for 20 metres

(the west side (refuge))

From its junction with A606 Main Road for the entire length of the refuge

2. Other restrictions: - **Bus Stop Clearway** – No Stopping At Any Time, except Buses
 - From its entrance to the public house car park in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Chapel Lane
