

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (TEWKESBURY CLOSE, WEST BRIDGFORD)  
(PROHIBITION OF LOADING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (8379)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be **Prohibited from Loading At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

**TEWKESBURY CLOSE, WEST BRIDGFORD (west to east section)**

(the north-west side)

- From its junction with Rodney Road in an easterly then north-easterly direction for 16 metres
- From a point 43 metres north-east of its junction with Rodney Road in an north-easterly direction for 20 metres

(the south-east side)

- From its junction with Rodney Road in an north-easterly direction for 7 metres
- From a point 46 metres north-east of its junction with Rodney Road in an north-easterly direction for 10 metres

**TEWKESBURY CLOSE, WEST BRIDGFORD (south to north section)**

(the north-east side)

- From the west to east section in a northerly direction for 27 metres

(the south-west side)

- From the west to east section in a northerly direction for 27 metres
