**WEST BRIDGFORD, NOTTINGHAMSHIRE - PROHIBITION OF WAITING, ON-STREET
PAY & DISPLAY/PAY BY PHONE PARKING PLACES – PUBLIC ADVERT**

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. We are writing to seek your views on some potential changes to on-street parking in West Bridgford, which we are proposing in response to public concern about a lack of parking space in the town.

The changes proposed are detailed below. There are a range of time-limited restrictions around the centre of West Bridgford ranging upwards from 30 minutes. We recognise that customers of the various types of retail businesses in the town will have different parking needs, so these proposals seek to reflect that, as well as simplifying existing restrictions wherever possible.

All existing short stay parking of up to 2 hours would be increased to a 3-hour maximum. In areas such as Bridgford Road, where there is some longer stay parking, we propose removing the upper limit on how long a vehicle can stay. In all locations a **free 30-minute period is proposed**, benefiting those who may only require a short stay. For roads such as Gordon Road, this effectively means no change to the free period currently available, but it introduces the option to pay for longer if required. For Fox and Hound Road adjacent to the cricket ground, although we are proposing a charge, we are also offering residents the option to purchase resident permits for the year.

The detailed proposals consist of the following:

Albert Road, Florence Road, Gordon Road, Gordon Square, Rectory Road (south) and Priory Road

- Conversion of all existing limited waiting parking areas into short-stay 3 hours pay and display with 30 minutes free parking.

Bridgford Road

- Conversion of existing free parking bays into long-stay pay and display bays (no upper daily limit) with 30 minutes free parking.

Church Drive, Davies Road and Rectory Road (north).

- Introduce new restrictions of short-stay 3 hours pay and display parking provision with 30 minutes free parking.

Fox Road and Hound Road

- Proposed new long stay pay and display (no upper daily limit) / residents parking.

Proposed **short stay** parking charges, **8am – 8pm (All Days) Max stay 3 hours**, will be as follows:

0 – 30 mins	Free
Up to 1 hr	£1.50
Up to 2 hrs	£2.50
Up to 3 hrs	£3.50

Proposed **long stay** parking charges, **8am – 8pm, (All Days)** will be as follows: -

0 – 30 mins	Free
Up to 1 hr	£1.50
Up to 2 hrs	£2.50
Up to 3 hrs	£3.50
Up to 4 hrs	£4.50
More than 4 hours	£6.00

The proposals are shown on the attached drawings H/SLW/4642/01 and H/SLW/4642/02.

Further to the initial consultation letter of 30th July 2024, the next stage of the consultation is to publicly advertise the scheme. The notice will be published in the Nottingham Post and notices will be fixed on site.

The proposed changes to the parking restrictions are being introduced to address public concern about a lack of parking space in the town.

Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter or email, by **11th October 2024**. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals please clearly state this and the reasons for your objection. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.

Any comments / objections made during the initial consultation stage will be carried forward to the advert stage of the consultation, therefore there is no requirement to resubmit your comments unless you want to add anything further.
