

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LANTERN LANE, SHARPLEY DRIVE, EAST LEAKE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE CLEARWAYS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (TRO 8385) AND PROVISION OF HUMPED ZEBRA CROSSING ON LANTERN LANE, EAST LEAKE

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire.

Nottinghamshire County Council has extended the existing traffic calming and installed a zebra crossing to assist pedestrians in crossing Lantern Lane to access both the primary and secondary schools and leisure centres.

As part of this scheme the Single Yellow Lines and School Keep Clear Marking road markings which Prohibit Stopping Mon – Fri 8 am – 4.30 pm in the area outside all of the schools and the Leisure Centre have been revised to make it easier and safer for pedestrians to access the school and Leisure Centre. This parking restriction is also required to help improve conditions for buses accessing/egressing the school site.

The scheme also includes providing junction protection to improve access and visibility for drivers when entering and exiting the junction of Sharpley Drive and Lantern Lane.
