

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PLATT LANE, KEYWORTH (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) AND (RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 2025 (8387)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Keyworth in the Borough of Rushcliffe in the County of Nottinghamshire.

- 1. The length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order shall be a Restricted Road (30mph) for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on that length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

• From a point 50 metres north-east of the north-eastern property boundary of Shelton Farm in a north-easterly direction for 17 metres

SCHEDULE 2

• From a point 67 metres north-east of the north-eastern property boundary of Shelton Farm in a north-easterly direction for 33 metres
