

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (NOTTINGHAM ROAD, CROPWELL BISHOP) (30MPH AND 50MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2025 (8390)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Cropwell Bishop in the Borough of Rushcliffe in the County of Nottinghamshire.

- 1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on that length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on that length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

NOTTINGHAM ROAD, CROPWELL BISHOP

From a point 116 metres north-west of its junction with Kinoulton Road in a north-westerly direction for 122 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

NOTTINGHAM ROAD, CROPWELL BISHOP

From a point 238 metres north-west of its junction with Kinoulton Road in a north-westerly direction for 966 metres.
