**CHURCH DRIVE, FAIRWAY, NOTTINGHAM ROAD, ROSE HILL, AND WILLOW BROOK,
KEYWORTH – PROPOSED DOUBLE YELLOW AND SINGLE YELLOW LINES (TRO 8408) –
STAGE 2 CONSULTATION**

Concerns have been received regarding inconsiderate and obstructive parking on Rose Hill, Nottingham Road and Church Drive junction and Fairway and Willow Brook junction, Keyworth which is causing congestion issues particularly for public transport.

To help address these concerns it is proposed to introduce Double Yellow Lines at the above junctions and a single yellow line opposite Willow Brook School

The proposals are shown on drawing H/SLW/5106/01.

Further to the revised initial consultation letter of 16th July 2024, the next stage of the consultation is to publicly advertise the scheme. The notice will be published in the Nottingham Post and notices will be fixed on site.

Any objections to the proposals, specifying the grounds on which they are made, should be sent in writing before **28th October 2025** using the e-mail or postal address at the bottom of the letter. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.

Please be advised that all comments regarding this scheme, made during the stage one consultation period, still remain valid throughout this stage two consultation period.
