

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOUNDARY ROAD AND SELBY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026 (8419)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be **prohibited from Waiting At Any Time** along the following length of road: -

BOUNDARY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD (the north-west side)

From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Selby Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction

SELBY ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD (both sides)

From its junction with Boundary Road in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres
