(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026 (8422)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. **Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

CROPSTON CLOSE, WEST BRIDGFORD (the north-east and north-west side)

- From a point 26 metres west of its junction with Swithland Drive in a south-westerly and then a north-westerly direction for 43 metres.
