

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LIME TREE AVENUE, CLUMBER PARK) (40 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025 (1303)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Clumber Park in the District of Bassetlaw, in the County of Nottinghamshire: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.

SCHEDULE

LIME TREE AVENUE, CLUMBER PARK

• From its junction with A614 Blyth Road in a south-westerly direction to a point 30 metres south-west of its junction with Piper Lane.
