Vehicles will be **Prohibited From Stopping Mon – Fri 8am – 4.30pm** along the following lengths of road: -

Sparken Hill, Worksop

(the north-east side)

- From a point 22 metres north of the centre line of the entrance to Sparken Hill Academy in a south-easterly direction for 44 metres.
