

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BRACKEN LANE, RETFORD) (NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE CLEARWAY) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (1289)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Retford in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. **Prohibition of Stopping Mon – Fri 8am – 4.30pm** along the following lengths of road: -

BRACKEN LANE, RETFORD (the north side)

- From a point 44 metres west of a point opposite the western kerbline of Rose Avenue in a westerly direction for 25 metres.

BRACKEN LANE, RETFORD (the south side)

- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Rose Avenue in a south-westerly direction for 68 metres.

2. Other restrictions: - **Bus Stop Clearway** – No Stopping Mon-Sat from 7am-7pm, except Buses

BRACKEN LANE, RETFORD (the north side)

- From a point 69 metres south-west of a point opposite the western kerbline of Rose Avenue in a south-westerly direction for 17 metres.
