## <u>B6045 BLYTH ROAD, WORKSOP- PROPOSED DOUBLE YELLOW LINES - PUBLIC ADVERT</u>

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. Concerns have been raised about buses struggling to navigate the road section between 67 Blyth Road and its junction with The Baulk due to inconsiderate parking. This is a busy section of the carriageway with buses needing to navigate downhill and around bends, so visibility can be reduced by these characteristics.

Further to the initial consultation letter of 24<sup>th</sup> September 2024, the next stage of the consultation is to publicly advertise the scheme. The advert will be published in the Worksop Guardian and notices will be fixed on site. A plan showing the extents of the proposed 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) is attached (Drawing Number H/JC/4795/01) along with a copy of the site notice.

The proposed 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) are being introduced to address inconsiderate and obstructive parking at this junction.

Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter or email, by **24**<sup>th</sup> **December 2024.** If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals please clearly state this and the reasons for your objection. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
