**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B6031 CARTER LANE,  
WARSOP VALE) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018 (2213)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Warsop Vale in the District of Mansfield:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road specified below

B6031 Carter Lane, Warsop Vale

- from its junction with Longster Lane in a north-easterly direction for 390 metres

2. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it related to Carter Lane, Warsop Vale from its junction with Longster Lane in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 390 metres is hereby revoked.

Between 17th January and 14th February 2018, Via East Midlands Ltd consulted on proposals to relocate the start of the 30 m.p.h speed limit to a point just west of the Mercury Garage, at the edge of the urban area of Warsop Vale. The rural stretch of road from Longster Lane to this point would then have become the national speed limit of 60 m.p.h.

Following consideration of comments received during the consultation period, it has been decided to amend the proposals to incorporate a speed limit of 40 m.p.h. between Longster Lane and the Mercury Garage, instead of 60 m.p.h.
