

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ELKESLEY ROAD AND KIRTON CLOSE, MEDEN VALE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (2254)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Meden Vale in the District of Mansfield: -

1. Proposed **prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

ELKESLEY ROAD, MEDEN VALE

(the north-east side)

- From a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Kirton Close in a south-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of that junction

(the south-west side)

- From a point opposite a point 58 metres south-east of the southern kerbline of Kirton Close in a southerly direction for 21 metres

KIRTON CLOSE, MEDEN VALE

(both sides)

- From its junction with Elkesley Road in an easterly direction for 10 metres

2. Proposed removal of **No Waiting At Any Time** restrictions along the following lengths of road: -

ELKESLEY ROAD, MEDEN VALE

(the north-east side)

- From the British Coal highway boundary in a south easterly direction for 233 metres

(the south-west side)

- From the British Coal highway boundary in a south-easterly direction for 279 metres
