

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BONINGTON ROAD AND SHELFORD HILL, MANSFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (2263)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

BONINGTON ROAD, (MANSFIELD) (the north-east side)

 From a point 17 metres south-east of its junction with Shelford Hill in a north-westerly direction to a point 8 metres north-west of that junction

SHELFORD HILL, (MANSFIELD) (the north-west side)

From its junction with Bonington Road in a north-easterly direction for 12 metres

SHELFORD HILL, (MANSFIELD) (the south-east side)

• From its junction with Bonington Road in a north-easterly direction for 21 metres
