

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Nursery Avenue, Sutton-in-Ashfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (4203)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in **Sutton-in-Ashfield** in the **District of Ashfield**:-

Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** in the following lengths of road:-

- Nursery Avenue (the east side) from its junction with Alfreton Road in a northerly direction for 47 metres.
- Nursery Avenue (the west side) from its junction with Alfreton Road in a northerly direction for 59 metres.

Written objections either by letter or email (stating grounds and quoting ref. 4203) must be received by me by **18th May 2018**.

The restrictions are required to prevent parking on the southern section of Nursery Avenue to ensure the free flow of vehicles accessing the new retail store.
