



## The Nottinghamshire County Council (High Pavement, Sutton In Ashfield) (Prohibition of Waiting & Parking Places) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (4204)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be on the following roads in Sutton In Ashfield in the District of Ashfield: -

1. to prohibit waiting at any time at the following locations,

**HIGH PAVEMENT -** From a point 102 metres south west of its junction with Forest Road/Station Road in a south westerly direction to a point 32 metres north east of its junction with The Titchwell

**HIGH PAVEMENT** - From a point 20 metres north east of its junction with The Titchwell to a point 32 metres south west of the centre line of The Titchwell.

**HIGH PAVEMENT** - From a point 49 metres north east of its junction with Silk Street in a south westerly direction to a point 8 metres south west of its junction with Silk Street

**HIGH PAVEMENT** - From a point 8 metres north west of its junction of Prospect Place in a south westerly direction to a point 23 metres south west of a point opposite the centre line of Mill Street

2. to introduce new parking bays. Bay to be Mon - Sat 8am- 6.30pm - 2 hours parking with no return within 1 hour at the following locations

**HIGH PAVEMENT -** From a point 32 metres north east of its junction with The Titchwell in a south westerly direction for a distance of 14 metres.

**HIGH PAVEMENT** - From a point 32 metres south west of the centre line of the Titchwell in a south westerly direction for a distance of 48 metres.

**HIGH PAVEMENT** - From a point 8 metres south west of the junction of Silk Street in a south westerly direction for a distance of 21 metres
