

The Nottinghamshire County Council
(B6009 Watnall Road and Shortwood Avenue, Hucknall) (Prohibition of
Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (4215)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Hucknall in the Borough of Ashfield:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along :-

Shortwood Avenue – (north- east side)

- From its junction with Shortwood Avenue in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres.

Shortwood Avenue – (south-west side)

- From its junction with Shortwood Avenue in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres.

Watnall Road (Hucknall)

- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Shortwood Avenue in a north-easterly direction to a point 14 meters north-east of the same junction.
