

The Nottinghamshire County Council
(Bishops Way and Church Lane, Hucknall) (Prohibition of Waiting)
Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (4216)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Hucknall in the District of Ashfield:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along : -

Bishops Way – (north- east side)

- From its junction with Church Lane in a south-easterly direction for 15 metres.

Bishops Way – (south-west side)

- From its junction with Church Lane in a south-easterly direction for 15 metres.

Church Lane - (south-west side)

- From a point 13 metres south-west of its junction with Bishops Way in a north-easterly direction to a point 15 metres north-east of the same junction.
