

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CUTTS ROW AND REFORM STREET, ANNESLEY WOODHOUSE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (4285)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Annesley Woodhouse the Borough of Ashfield: -

1. Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

CUTTS ROW, ANNESLEY WOODHOUSE

• (the south-east side) From its junction with Reform Street in a north-easterly direction for 8 metres

REFORM STREET, ANNESLEY WOODHOUSE

• (the north-east side) From its junction with Cutts Row in a south-easterly direction for 8 metres
